<b>Sl. No.</b>	<b>The school is directed to ensure that :</b>
1	The total number of sections of BalVatika shall be restricted to 3 (one each in Bal Vatika I,II,III respectively ). The total number of sections from Classes I to X shall be restricted to 10. Any further increase shall require prior approval of the Board, subject to compliance with affiliation bye laws and availability of rooms of 500 sq. ft. dimension.
2	The school shall submit an undertaking that it will start bal vatika sections in the academic session, 24-25 and upload the same on SARAS portal within 3months.
3	The composite lab is seen as under sized and congested and not properly laid out. only chemistry section is seen. no biology equipment and samples are seen, only models are placed on the second work station. There is no lab standard table for Physics section and its equipment is displayed on a side table, where experiments can not be conducted.No seating, storage and safety measures like separate entry and exit, fir extinguishers and exhaust fans are seen. Curtains, which are a fire hazard are seen, which must be removed. the school shall upgrade the lab as per sops issued by the board within 3months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
4	The school should make arrangement for seating and upgrade the Maths Lab with more learning aids and submit the compliance on SARAS portal through a videography within 3 months.

5	The school should create a separate reading area for staff and submit the compliance on SARAS portal through a videography within 3 months.
6	Separate toilets for CWSN, boys and girls are not seen on every floor. Those seen in the video are regular cubicles, which are too narrow and small for a wheelchair/walker to navigate as is evident in the video. WC is also placed incorrectly, in a way which makes them difficult to use by CWSN. The school shall re construct separate toilets for CWSN boys and girls on every floor with proper permanent signage, as per norms of RPwD Act and guidelines issued by the board within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
7	The ramp to access the upper floors is still under construction. the school shall affix hand rails on both sides of the ramp and complete construction within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography. Students are seen playing next to under construction portion of the building. The school shall properly cordon it off for the safety of students and staff.
8	The school should ensure mandatory training of teachers with CoE Chandigarh and submit compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws- 2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted with in the stipulated 3 months , the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
